**ASSIGNMENT: CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR SUPERVISION OF CONSTRUCTION WORKS FOR KABUYANDA SCHEME ROADS, SCHEME BUILDINGS AND SANITATION FACILITIES**

Government of Uganda has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Irrigation for Climate Resilience Project (ICRP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for **Consultancy services for supervision of construction works for Kabuyanda Scheme Roads, Scheme Buildings and Sanitation facilities**

The overall objective of the assignment is to supervise the construction works to be executed under two different works contracts namely; Construction of Kabuyanda Scheme roads and Construction of Kabuyanda Scheme buildings & sanitation facilities, through prudent contracts management, to ensure: conformity and compliance to design specifications and design modifications; quality control and assurance; performance monitoring for the infrastructure during defects period, and adherence to the World Bank and National Environmental and Social Safeguard Policies and requirements.

The implementation period of the assignment is twenty-six (26) Calendar months disaggregated as follows: (i) Pre-Construction appraisal phase Months; (ii) Construction phase (12 calendar months) and (iii) Defects liability phase (12 calendar months).

The Ministry of Water and Environment (MWE) now invites eligible firms to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested firms should provide sufficient information demonstrating that they meet the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services. The shortlisting criteria will include;

1. Minimum of 15 years of core business as a consultant in undertaking construction supervision of civil infrastructure works, particularly in road construction works and civil structures.
2. The Consultant should demonstrate experience in executing at least two (02) similar assignments within the last 10 years as follows:
  - (a) One (1) of the two (02) assignments shall involve construction supervision of gravel roads in Sub-Saharan Africa, with a minimum construction supervision contract value of US\$ 0.20 million.
  - (b) One (1) of the two (02) assignments shall involve construction supervision of building structures in Sub-Saharan Africa, with a minimum construction supervision contract value of US\$ 0.10 million.
3. The Consultant must submit firm's organogram to demonstrate technical and managerial capability.
4. Presence of appropriate skills among experts including; Resident Engineer/Road Engineer/Team Leader, Civil/Structural Engineer/ Assistant Resident Engineer, Materials Engineer, Clerk of Works – Roads, Clerk of Works – Structures, Environmental Safeguards Specialist, Social Safeguards Specialist. **(Please do not submit CVs and bio data of experts at this stage).**

The attention of interested consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs 3.14, 3.16 and 3.17 of the World Bank's 'Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers' November 2020 [Procurement in investment Project Financing; Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services, setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the **Consultant Qualification Selection (CQS)** Method set out in the World Bank Procurement Regulations (July 2016, revised November 2017, August 2018 and November 2020).
