

LAND MANAGEMENT LICENSING SYSTEM

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The Land Management Licensing System is an online platform managed by the Department of Forestry Management to facilitate the application, processing and management of licenses and permits for approved activities on forest land.

The system supports the Ministry's efforts to improve efficiency, transparency, accountability and accessibility in the administration of forestry-related licences and services.

Key Services

- i. The system provides a platform for applicants and authorised users to:
- ii. Submit applications for relevant licences and permits.
- iii. Access information on licensing requirements and procedures.
- iv. Facilitate processing and tracking of applications.
- v. Support assessment and approval of authorised activities on forest land.
- vi. Maintain records of licences, permits and related transactions.
- vii. Improve transparency and accountability in the management of forest resources.

Benefits

The Land Management Licensing System contributes to efficient and transparent forest governance by reducing manual processes, improving record management and providing a structured platform for managing applications.

It also supports the Ministry's mandate to ensure that activities undertaken on forest land are properly regulated and consistent with approved forest management objectives, environmental safeguards and applicable laws and regulations.
