Critical challenges affecting the sector performance

- Low sector uptake of ENR mainstreaming in high impact
- Limited capacity for mainstreaming at central and local government levels
- Limited financial resources
- Lack of monitoring, reporting and evaluation framework for mainstreaming

Proposed undertakings
