- 1. The Government of Uganda through the Ministry of Water & Environment has allocated funds for the procurement of Consultancy Services for Assessment of Climate-Induced Loss and Damage in Uganda.
- 2. The Ministry of Water and Environment now invites eligible consulting firms to submit sealed expressions of interest for consultancy services.

	2.2 Specific objectives	
	The specific objectives of assessing the climate-related loss and damage are:	
	i. Assess the extent of degradation of forests and wetlands in the cattle corridor of the country.	
	ii. Assess loss and damage due to extreme events at cattle corridor districts affected by the climate-related hazards.	
	iii. Identify potential risks and quantify the losses and damages due to the identified climate-related extreme events.	
	iv. Identify key stakeholders at national, local government and community-based level and engage the stakeholders in the assessment processes of loss and damage.	
	v. Assess community perceptions on climate-induced loss and damage and their perspectives on minimizing the losses and damages; and	
	vi. Provide policy recommendations and develop an implementation strategy for minimizing climate-induced loss and damage.	
	Duration of the Assignment: 18 calendar months	

- 3. Interested consultants should provide information demonstrating that they are eligible and possess the required qualifications to perform the services supported with relevant documentation.
- 4. The shortlisting criteria will include: Experience in previous contracts of a similar nature; strategy in water related activities; Successful bidders should not have conflict of interest in relation to the subject of the procurement, should not be suspended by PPDA, and must demonstrate legal capacity to contract. Bidders should also provide a cover letter, valid trading licence, Certificate of Incorporation, Memorandum and Articles of Association, company profile, Powers of Attorney, evidence of being a local provider. "Local provider" means a provider registered in Uganda whose majority ownership is held by Ugandan citizens. Documents to be submitted in the bid as proof of eligibility to be a local provider include; Return of Allotment of Shares; and copies of the national identity cards or passports of the majority shareholders. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications. The form of association, where applicable, should be indicated in the Expression of Interest.
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- 6. Preference schemes shall Not apply when evaluating Request for Proposals from the shortlisted consultants.
- 7. Interested eligible consultants may obtain further information at the address given below from **Monday to** Friday, 08:00 17:00 hours, except on public holidays.
- 8. Sealed Expressions of Interest must be delivered to the address below at or before 11:00 hours, 13<sup>th</sup> April 2021.
